All deliveries and placement of materials are subject to delivery driver's discretion. If driver deems placement unsuitable and owner/agent cannot be contacted, a re-delivery fee may apply. Local street use ordinances and permitting are the responsibility of the buyer, including, but not limited to, providing flaggers. Note:

Efflorescence is a whitish powder like deposit of calcium carbonate that may appear on concrete products. It is a by-product of the hydration process and is inherent in all concrete products. It will usually wash or wear off in the course of time. If you do not wish to wait for the natural process to occur, cleaners designed specifically for removal are available. Efflorescence in no way affects the integrity of the product, and is not a cause for rejection.
